Charles G. Stark, treasurer of the Moro Province, George L. Coleman, district auditor, and James M. Browne, in charge of land assessments, Zamboanga, are hereby appointed an appraisement committee to pass upon the location, condition, present actual value, and present market value of all lands, buildings, and structures in the city of Zamboanga, Moro Province, concerning which such information is requested by the Postal Savings Bank Investment Board.

This committee will meet at such times and places in the city of Zamboanga as it may find necessary and will promptly submit to the Postal Savings Bank Investment Board a report of its findings in each instance, together with such other information relative to such lands, buildings, and structures as said board may from time to time request.
