PROCLAMATION No. 414

DECLARING MONDAY, JULY 12, 1965, AS A SPECIAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCES OF COTABATO, LANAO DEL NORTE, LANAO DEL SUR AND SULU, AND IN THE CITIES OF BASILAN, COTABATO, ILIGAN AND MARAWI.

In connection with the Muslim National Feast of Mauleed-En-Nabi, I, Diosdado Macapagal, President of the Philippines, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 30 of the Revised Administrative Code, do hereby declare Monday, July 12, 1965, as a special public holiday in the provinces of Cotabato, Lanao del Norte, Lanao del Sur and Sulu, and in the cities of Basilan, Cotabato, Iligan and Marawi.

Muslim officials and employees of the Government, both national and local, performing their duties and functions outside of the provinces and cities above stated, shall be exempted from duty during this feast day, which, for purposes of this proclamation, shall be considered as a special public holiday for said officials and employees in their respective stations.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 8th day of July, in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and sixty-five.
