PROCLAMATION No. 456

DECLARING SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 25, 1965, AS A SPECIAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY IN THE PROV-INCE OF ALBAY.

WHEREAS, Saturday, September 25, 1965, marks the 62nd anniversary of the surrender of General Simeon Ola, one of the last Filipino generals to surrender during the Filipino-American War; and

WHEREAS, the people of his province should be afforded an opportunity to celebrate the event with appropriate ceremonies;

Now, THEREFORE, I, Diosdado Macapagal, President of the Philippines, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 30 of the Revised Administrative Code, do hereby declare Saturday, September 25, 1965, as a special public holiday in the Province of Albay.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.
