PROCLAMATION NO. 53

REVOKING PROCLAMATION NO. 510 DATED DECEMBER 20, 1965,
WHICH RESERVED PARCELS OF THE PRIVATE DOMAIN IN
PANDACAN, MANILA, FOR THE PHILIPPINE COLLEGE OF
COMMERCE, AND RESERVING THE AREA EMBRACED THEREIN
FOR THE USE OF THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by law, I,
FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, do
hereby revoke Proclamation No. 510 dated December 20,
1965, which reserved for the use of the Philippine
College of Commerce the parcels of land reserved for
the Bureau of Animal Industry in Pandacan, Manila, and
reserve the same for the use of the national government.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and
caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be
affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 22nd day of July,
in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
