PROCLAMATION NO. 350

DECLARING MONDAY, 23 APRIL 2012, AS A SPECIAL (NON-WORKING)  
DAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PLARIDEL, PROVINCE OF BULACAN

**WHEREAS**, Monday, 23 April 2012, marks the commemoration of the Battle of Quingua which took place in 1899;

**WHEREAS**, the Battle of Quingua, wherein the Filipino forces were under the command of General Gregorio del Pilar, was one of the most significant victories of the Filipinos in the war; and

**WHEREAS**, it is but fitting and proper that the people of the Municipality of Plaridel, Bulacan be given full opportunity to celebrate and participate in the occasion with appropriate ceremonies.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, PAQUITO N. OCHOA JR.**, Executive Secretary, by authority of His Excellency, **BENIGNO S. AQUINO III**, do hereby declare Monday, 23 April 2012, as a special (non-working) day in the Municipality of Plaridel, Bulacan.
