Special Provisions

1. *Special Expenses.* Of the amount appropriated herein, such amounts as may be necessary shall be made available for (a) hosting of the World Tourism Conference, (b) hosting of the Sixth World Congress of the International Agricultural Librarians and Documentalists and (c) other contributions and/or costs of approved participation or hosting of international organizations and conferences.

2. *Administration of the Fund.* The amount herein authorized for Program 1.0 shall be administered by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in coordination with NEDA and the amount authorized for Program 2.0 shall be administered by the Ministry of the Budget.

3. *Philippine Government Pledge to the Third World International Stabilization Fund.* Of the amount appropriated in this Act, the amount of ₱375,000,000 shall be made available in compliance with the Philippine pledge in support of an International Commodities Stabilization Fund as may be established by UNCTAD, to be released subject to the approval of the President (Prime Minister).

4. *ASEAN Commitments.* Of the amount appropriated herein, such sums as may be necessary shall be made available to support Philippine Commitments to ASEAN complementation projects, including commodity price stabilization agreements.

5. *Key Budgetary Inclusions (KBI).* The amounts herein appropriated for the various programs and projects of the fund shall specifically provide for the activities and purposes in the indicated amounts and conditions:
